Title: I Street Bridge Replacement Project

Applicant: City of Sacramento

Location: Sovereign land in the Sacramento River, adjacent to and within Assessor's Parcel Numbers 002-0010-018 and 002-0010-023 in Sacramento County and adjacent to Assessor's Parcel Numbers 010-102-005, 010-102-003, and 010-102-010 in Yolo County.

Description: The proposed project would construct a new bridge over the Sacramento River between Sacramento and West Sacramento to replace the vehicular crossing that is provided by the existing I Street Bridge. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 20-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through February 25, 2044.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on February 26, 2024, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was prepared pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, the city of Sacramento (City), certified the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and Mitigation Monitoring Plan and approved the project on June 25, 2019. The California State Lands Commission has considered the EIR as prepared for this project by the City and adopted an independent Mitigation Monitoring Program.
