**Project Title:** County of San Mateo Routine Maintenance Program (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0144-R3)

**Project Location:** The project sites are in San Mateo County, State of California. Routine maintenance activities will occur at County maintained facilities (e.g., channels, culverts, roads, bridges, trails, and other recreation facilities) some of which cross creeks, tributaries, springs, and other waterways.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0144-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, County of San Mateo.

Under this Agreement, Permittee will conduct "routine maintenance activities" within San Mateo County pursuant to the Routine Maintenance Manual. Activities may include maintenance of culverts, storm drain facilities, bridges, roadside ditches, and swales; channel maintenance; bank stabilization; sediment removal; vegetation management; and road and trail maintenance.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on September 22, 2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project  will /  will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
