**Project Title:** Zinfandel Residential Development Projects (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. AMA-17180-R2)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located at the Zinfandel Residential Development, adjacent to two (2) ephemeral drainages which flow into Little Indian Creek, in the City of Plymouth, County of Amador, State of California; Latitude 38.469652, Longitude -120.870735; Section 10, Township 07N, Range 10E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Amador City, Mount Diablo Meridian.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number AMA-17180-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Zinfandel Development LLC, as represented by Bob Reeder.

The Project includes the construction of an extension to Zinfandel Parkway, which is proposed to cross two (2) separate ephemeral drainages (Drainages 1 and 6), both of which flow into Little Indian Creek. Arch culverts with concrete footings will be constructed to cross drainages.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project  will /  will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
