The County has prepared this Recirculated EIR to adequately address the potential health impacts associated with the project's emissions of criteria air pollutants and toxic air contaminants in accordance with the direction provided by the Court. The document provides the additional analysis required by the Supreme Court with sufficient detail and clarity to describe the nature and magnitude of the health impacts from the project's emissions. This Recirculated Draft EIR focuses on updating and amending the previous EIR's air quality analysis to be consistent with the California Supreme Court's direction in the Friant Ranch Decision.

This could be considered the major area of controversy associated with the project since certification of the EIR in 2011. The County has and will continue to respond to this issue, including most recently in the Recirculated EIR.
