Project Location (include county): The located adjacent to the existing rail line south of Harry Bridges Boulevard and on the northern property line of the TraPack Container Terminal in the Community of Wilmington in Los Angeles County.

Project Description: The project will construct 5,000 feet of mainline track and crossovers in the Port of Los Angeles, eliminating a short gap of single track serving the TraPac Container Terminal and the West Basin Container Terminal on-dock railyards, automating train control hardware and software, and providing a second track for unimpeded dock movements to and from both of these railyards and the Alameda Corridor, helping to eliminate the potential for train collisions.
