

Confidential Appendix E3. Tribal Cultural Resources Consultation Efforts Memorandum

Archaeological site locations are exempt from the California Public Records Act as specified in Government Code, Section 6254.10, and the Freedom of Information Act (Exemption 3) under the legal authority of both the National Historic Preservation Act (Public Law 102-574, Section 304[a]) and the Archaeological Resources Protection Act (Public Law 96-95, Section 9[a]). Sections of this report contain maps and other sensitive information.

Distribution should be restricted appropriately.

Access to the confidential cultural resources studies for the Fanita Ranch Project is limited under the legal authority of both the National Historic Preservation Act (Public Law 102-574, Section 304[a]) and the Archaeological Resources Protection Act (Public Law 96-95, Section 9[a]). Individuals who meet the Secretary of the Interior's Professional Qualifications Standards or California State Personnel Board Specification for Associate State Archaeologist or are a representative of a tribal government may request to view the reports by appointment at the City's Department of Development Services. At the time of the request, the individual shall provide a copy of their qualifications to the City of Santee and will provide a letter stating that they agree to not distribute the confidential documents.
