The primary project components evaluated in this SEIR are the following (further details are set forth in Table 3-2 and Section 3.6 in Chapter 3, Project Description, of this SEIR): New Aquatics Center and Pool Replacement Project; Performing Arts Plaza Project; Athletic Fields Turf and Storage Project. The project also includes the following components that are not evaluated in detail in this SEIR because they do not have the potential to cause significant environmental impacts not already evaluated in the 2017 EIR: Gym and PE Spaces Modernization Project; Arts Building Project (AR Building); AD, SC, TE, MU, LA Building Modernization Project; Landscaping, Site Work, and Fencing Project.
