Project Title: Spring Canyon VTTM 48086 Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0211-R5)

Project Location (Los Angeles County): The project site is located north of the Antelope Valley Freeway and Soledad Canyon Road between Mammoth Lane and Agua Dulce Canyon Road in the northwest portion of unincorporated Los Angeles County at latitude 34.449273°N and longitude -118.369716° W. The following Assessor's Parcel Numbers are associated with the Project site: 285-406-100-1, 285-406-100-5, 285-406-100-6, 285-406-100-9, 321-102-104-3, 321-102-104-4, 321-102-104-5, 321-102-104-6, 321-102-104-8, 321-102-105-0, 321-102-105-1, and 321-102-190-0.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has amended and extended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement 1600-2018-0211-R5, pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, Jon Schumaker, Spring Canyon Recovery Acquisition, LLC.

The project has been amended to extend the due date to establish an endowment for the long term management of the mitigation lands and extend the term to December 31, 2028.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on December 19, 2024, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings **were** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
