
Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has amended Streambed Alteration Agreement (1600-2013-0186-R5), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, Lost Canyons, LLC., as represented by John McClure.

The project is amended to reinstate approximately 0.30 acres of impacts from the widening and realignment of Tapo Canyon Road which were removed from the Agreement by a previous amendment (July 26, 2021).

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on March 25, 2025 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were not** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by C-DFW for this project.
6. Findings **were** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
