## Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

Proposal to construct a charter school, which comprises an approximately 17,757-square-foot main building (for classrooms, offices, a multipurpose room, and a library/resource area), an 8,000-square-foot gym, two 900-square-foot portable buildings (for additional offices and independent learning), a 54,000-square-foot sports field, two basketball courts, a kindergarten play area, the related parking lot, and a 5-foot-wide Class II bicycle lane along with bicycle parking facilities. The existing charter school location (approximately 1.75 miles north of the proposed charter school location) will remain under the control of the local school district (Fort Sage Unified). The subject parcels are zoned A-1 (General Agricultural District) and A-1-H (General Agricultural District, Highway Combining District) and have an "Intensive Agriculture," land use designation in the Lassen County General Plan, 2000, the latter according to Planning Commission Resolution Number 02-04-01. The project site is located approximately one quarter mile north of the Town of Doyle at the intersection of Doyle Loop Road and U.S. Highway 395 at 435-500 Doyle Loop Road. All development is currently proposed at APN 141-050-95.
