**PROJECT LOCATION:** The existing waste water treatment plant (WWTP) is located at 3425 Live Oak Road, in the unincorporated community of Cottonwood, California. The collection system improvements, including improvements to the lift stations and sewer pipeline replacement, will take place at various locations in the community of Cottonwood.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Project will consist of repairing 16 pipeline mechanical deficiencies, rehabilitating eight (8) manholes, and replacing approximately 5,700 linear feet of pipeline sags. The existing Cottonwood lift station will be replaced, and new equipment will be placed at the Black Lane and Quail Lane lift stations.

This is to advise that the State Water Board made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations and approved CWSRF financing on December 26, 2019 for the Project:

1. Determinations were made pursuant to the CEQA.
2. The State Water Board considered the MND as prepared by the County for this Project.
3. A Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program was adopted by the County for this Project.
4. Mitigation measures were made a condition of the County's approval of the Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by the County for this Project.
