**Project Location (include county):** The project is located in the City of Corona, within the El Sobrante Landfill, in the County of Riverside, State of California


**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0091-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, USA Waste of California, as represented by Joseph Walstrom.

The project proposes the filling of four drainages with landfill material and installation of a 24-inch downdrain to capture stormwater flows in support of landfill operations

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on November 24, 2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
