Project Location: The facility is located in an unincorporated area of Riverside County at 10910 Dawson Canyon Rd, Corona, CA- east of Interstate 15, Temescal Canyon Road, south of Cajalco Road, and north of Dawson Canyon in Western Riverside County (Portions of Sections 23, 24, 25, and 26, Township 4S, Range 6W and Portions of Section 19; Township 4S; Range 5W).

Project Description: The Project is a proposal to revise the EI Sobrante Landfill Solid Waste Facility Permit to allow for the following operational changes: 1) Extend the hours at the gate for waste delivery by four (4) hours, thus allowing for acceptance of material for a continuous 24-hour period; and, 2) Change the maximum disposal tonnage limits from a daily limit of 10,000 tons per day (tpd) to a weekly limit of 70,000 tons per week.

This is to advise that the Riverside County Board of Supervisors has approved the above-referenced project on March 31, 2009 and has made the following determinations regarding that project:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment, because impacts were avoided or previously mitigated through mitigation measures adopted as part of the Expansion EIR (SCH No. 90020076).
2. A SEIR was prepared and certified for this project pursuant to the provisions of the CEQA.
3. Pursuant to Section 15163(e) of CEQA, CEQA Guidelines, the Expansion EIR is considered revised upon approval of the project.
4. An updated Mitigation Monitoring Program was adopted with approval of this project.
5. Findings were made in accordance with Section 15091 of CEQA, CEQA Guidelines.
6. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this project.
