Project Description: The proposed Sunnyvale and East and West Channels Flood Protection Project would provide flood protection for residents, businesses, and infrastructure along a 9.5 mile length of the Sunnyvale East and West channels. The Flood Protection Project consists of developing new flood protection infrastructure necessary to provide 100-year riverine flood protection, developing water quality improvements where possible, and recreational improvements. The Flood Protection Project would include floodwalls, levee and maintenance road improvements, bridge/culvert modifications, and sediment removal. The Flood Protection Project also includes repairing and stabilizing several stream bank sections that are unstable and actively eroding.

The Sunnyvale East & West Channels Flood Protection Project (Google Project Reach/Borregas-Bordeaux Bridge) includes improvements on Valley Water Property and Google Property, including the installation of (i) the Google Trails; (ii) a new bridge crossing the West Channel on Valley Water Property for use by pedestrians and bicyclists, including associated headwalls (Channel Bridge Headwalls); (iii) a new raised floodwall on the west bank of the West Channel between the Channel Bridge and the existing floodwall constructed as part of the Moffett Place Development Channel Improvement Project for a span of approximately 450 feet and a new floodwall on the east bank of the West Channel for a span of approximately 214 feet, including construction of inboard in-situ walls to negate the need for in-channel work; (iv) native plantings and an associated irrigation system adjacent to the Channel Bridge; and (v) lighting and other appurtenant improvements. In addition to the improvements and new infrastructure, Google would revise

The City of Sunnyvale prepared the Second Addendum to the Flood Protection Project's Final EIR, which describes design changes to the previously approved Project including design changes to be implemented by Google and analyzes the environmental effects that could result from the Flood Protection Project changes.

Addendum to the Santa Clara Valley Water District's Sunnyvale East and West Channels Flood Protection Project Final EIR

- Pursuant to Section 15164 of the CEQA Guidelines, the City of Sunnyvale prepared an Addendum to the Sunnyvale East and West Channels Flood Protection Project's Final EIR. The Addendum describes design changes to the previously approved Project and analyzes the environmental effects that could result from the Flood Protection Project changes.
- The Sunnyvale East and West Channels Flood Protection Project Final EIR was approved and NOD was filed as shown in Attachment I.
- As per Fish and Wildlife and California Code sections:
