Project Description:

Implementation of a remedial action plan for remediation of groundwater contamination at and in the vicinity of Chino Airport. Remedial action efforts include installation of 10 extraction well clusters, approximately 28,000 linear feet of pipeline, and one or two groundwater treatment systems.

Public Agency Approving Project: The Chino Basin Desalter Authority is carrying out the Project. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Drinking Water (DDW), is the Responsible Agency for the Project. The Division of Drinking Water has approved for the above described Project on 03/01/2023, and has made the following California Environmental Quality Act Determinations regarding the project:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to the effects within the State Water Board's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. The State Water Board has considered the Initial Study Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were not made a condition of the State Water Board's approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was not adopted by the State Water Board for the Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by the State Water Board for the Project.
6. Findings were not made by the State Water Board pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
