Project Title: Dola Ditch Bridge Replacement (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. [EPIMS-SBR-42970-R6])

Project Location ([San Bernardino County]): The Project is located at an unnamed stream to Bristol Lake, along National Trails Highway/Historic Route 66 in the County of San Bernardino, State of California; Latitude 34.560846, Longitude -115.606247.


Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-SBR-42970-R6), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, San Bernardino County – Public Works.

The project is limited to the replacement of the existing timber bridge at Dola ditch with a new, reinforced concrete bridge. Construction activities include: relocation of existing utility lines, including fiber optic telecommunication line and solar powered local utility lines which are currently tied to the bridge or adjacent to the bridge; removing existing guardrails, bridge deck, and transition structures; removal of existing piles and necessary grading; and construction of a new bridge.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on March 21, 2024 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW’s permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW’s approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
