Project Title: Permanente Creek Restoration Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No.1600-2020-0195-R3)

Project Location (include county): The Project is located between U.S. Highway 101 and Charleston Road, City of Mountain View, Santa Clara County, California, 94043. The coordinates are 37.420621° N latitude and -122.08672° W longitude (NAD 83 or WGS 84). The Assessor's Parcel Numbers are 116-08-105, 116-08-101, 116-09-094, and 116-09-108.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0195-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Google LLC.

The overall Google Landings project includes demolishing existing buildings and parking lots and construction of an office building and parking structure. The portion of the Project, covered under this Agreement, includes widening Permanente Creek to accommodate 100-year event flows, construction of a pedestrian bridge, trail connection and observation platform, and establishment of riparian habitat through planting and vegetation maintenance.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on July 29, 2021, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
