Project Title: Sweeney Ranch Pump Station (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-57886-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at an intermittent ditch tributary to Morrison Creek, in the County of Sacramento, State of California; Latitude 38.45080, Longitude -121.49082 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees); Assessor's Parcel Number 119-0190-020-0000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SAC-57886-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Sacramento Area Flood Control Agency.

The project is limited to the replacement of the Sweeney Ranch Pump Station which will involve the demolition of the existing pump station facility and construction of a new concrete pump station along with an access road.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
