Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Lagunitas Creek, at 14000 Point Reyes-Petaluma Road, in the census-designated place of Point Reyes Station, unincorporated County of Marin. The project is approximately 1.55 miles east of the intersection of State Route 1 and Point Reyes-Petaluma Road at approximately Latitude 38.080876°N, Longitude 122.775175°W.
