**Project Title:** Black Mountain Ranch Stream Crossing (Major Amendment to Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement, EPIMS No. MAN-21152-R3)

**Project Location (Marin County):** The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Lagunitas Creek, at 14000 Point Reyes-Petaluma Road, in the census-designated place of Point Reyes Station, unincorporated County of Marin. The project is approximately 1.55 miles east of the intersection of State Route 1 and Point Reyes-Petaluma Road at approximately Latitude 38.080876°N, Longitude 122.775175°W.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed a Major Amendment to Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. MAN-21152-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Super Farm, LLC.

The Major Amendment is limited to installation of a 30-foot extension to a 54-inch diameter culvert, resulting in the originally permitted 40-foot culvert increasing in length to 70 feet.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on June 8, 2023 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings **were not** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of project approval as a Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
