Project Title: Willow Creek Bridge on Carbondale Road Replacement Project Minor Amendment No. 2 (California Endangered Species Act Incidental Take Permit No. 2081-2018-073-02 (ITP)).

Project Location: The Project site is located at the intersection of Forest Home Road and Carbondale Road where Carbondale Road Crosses over Willow Creek; in the County of Amador, State of California; Latitude 38.448190, Longitude -120.9629090; Sections 22 and 23, Township 7N, Range 9E of the Mt. Diablo Meridian, U.S. Geologic Survey (USGS) 7.5 quad Irish Hill.

Project Description: The proposed Project is a minor amendment to Incidental Take Permit (ITP) No. 2081-2018-073-02. The minor amendment modifies Condition of Approval 5.2 Designated Biologist to add in the option for a Biological Monitor during periods when the Covered Species is not expected to be present and modifies Condition of Approval 6.3 Compliance Monitoring to add in the option of a Biological Monitor during compliance monitoring.

This is to advise that California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW), acting as a responsible agency executed the above-described Incidental Take Permit on the date signed below and made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment (This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a responsible agency).
2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared by the lead agency for the original project.
3. Additional mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to Public Resources Code § 21081(a). CDFW did, however, adopt findings to document its compliance with CEQA.
7. Compliance with the environmental filing fee requirement at Fish and Game Code § 711.4 were confirmed with a copy of a receipt showing prior payment was submitted to CDFW.
