**Project Title:** Willow Creek Bridge on Carbondale Road Bridge Replacement (Streambed Alteration Agreement Notification No. 1600-2019-0142-R2)

**Project Location (include county):** The project site is located at the intersection of Forest Home Road and Carbondale Road where Carbondale Road Crosses over Willow Creek in the County of Amador, State of California, Latitude 38.448190, Longitude -120.9629090, Sections 22 and 23, Township 7N, Range 9E of the Mt. Diablo Meridian, U.S. Geologic Survey (USGS) 7.5 quad Irish Hill.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has extended Streambed Alteration Agreement Notification Number 1600-2019-0142-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Amador County Department of Public Works.

The existing Streambed Alteration Agreement expiration date will be extended from January 8, 2025, to January 8, 2030. No modifications to the project description have been made.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, extended the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.

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- 6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
