

10 DISTRIBUTION LIST

Since publication of the Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR)/Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), the following substantive changes have been made to this chapter:

- This chapter has been revised to reflect notice and distribution of the Final EIR/EIS, including updates to the introduction to Chapter 10, Distribution List, and Section 10.1, Repository Locations.
- Section 10.2, Federal Agencies, was revised to consistently list the appropriate cabinet agencies.
- Section 10.4, Elected Officials, was updated to include officials elected in 2020 after publication of the Draft EIR/EIS.

The distribution of the Final EIR/EIS emphasizes the importance of providing the documents in a number of different formats so that the information is fully accessible to members of the public. The distribution strategy includes the use of electronic media to support cost-effective, broad availability to the public and interested parties. The entire Final EIR/EIS (Volumes 1–4) is available on the California High-Speed Rail Authority’s (Authority) website (www.hsr.ca.gov). The entire Final EIR/EIS is also available for review in electronic format at the repository locations listed below (open days/hours may be reduced for compliance with coronavirus public health and safety directives). Repository locations also hold a hard copy of Volume 1 of the Final EIR/EIS. Printed copies of the Final EIR/EIS (Volumes 1–4) are available for review at the Authority’s Headquarters (700 L Street, Suite 620 MS-1, Sacramento, CA 95814) and the Northern California Regional Office (100 Paseo de San Antonio, Suite 300, San Jose, CA 95113). Electronic copies of the Final EIR/EIS are available upon request by calling (800) 455-8166 or by request at <https://hsr.ca.gov/contact/>.

All persons, agencies, and organizations listed in this chapter have been informed of the availability of the Final EIR/EIS and locations to obtain or review copies. Notice of availability of the Final EIR/EIS has been published in the *Federal Register*. Repositories listed in Section 10.1 were sent a hard copy of Volume 1 of the Final EIR/EIS and several electronic copies of the Final EIR/EIS (open days/hours may be reduced for compliance with coronavirus public health and safety directives). Cooperating federal agencies also received a copy of the Final EIR/EIS in their preferred method. The Notice of Availability (NOA) was filed with each of the County Clerks’ offices in Santa Clara, San Benito, and Merced Counties. Other federal agencies, state agencies, and interested parties listed below have been mailed a copy of the NOA of the Final EIR/EIS. The NOA included information translated into the primary languages of the project vicinity: Vietnamese, Mandarin, and Spanish. The NOA also serves as notification for an upcoming Authority Board meeting and provides information about how to access the Final EIR/EIS. Federal, state, and county elected officials, mayors of cities with possible stations, the potentially affected local agencies listed below, and members of the public who subscribed to the project mailing list, had attended project events (e.g., scoping, public meetings, etc.), or had sent comments or questions via email on the Authority’s website also received the mailed NOA. In addition, the NOA was sent to property owners adjacent to the four San Jose to Central Valley Wye project alternatives.

The NOA for the Final EIR/EIS was also distributed through the Authority’s social media accounts and by email to individuals who had previously registered to receive information via email about the document.

In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, all notification materials advise the public to refer to the Authority’s website for the latest information regarding availability of the document and consideration of the document at an upcoming Authority Board meeting.

The sections below include eight main groupings for distribution: repository locations, federal agencies, state agencies, elected officials, regional/local agencies, organizations and businesses, Native American contacts, and schools. Locations and point of contact names are noted where appropriate.
