Project Location: The Project will occur in and adjacent to the Friant-Kern Canal at the State Route 201 crossing, approximately 5.5 miles northwest of Woodlake in Tulare County, California; Southeast ¼ of Section 33, Township 16 South, Range 26 East, USGS 7.5 Minute Quad Map Ivanhoe, MDB & M; Latitude 36.485083, Longitude -119.156789.

Project Description: The Project includes activities related to widening of the bridge at the State Route 201 crossing over the Friant-Kern Canal. Project activities will include water diversion, temporary access road construction, bridge column construction, bridge deck widening, bridge railing replacement, road resurfacing, and the placement of rock slope protection. On December 16, 2020, Caltrans requested a reduction in days of forecasted rainfall preceding concrete pouring, constituting this Major Amendment No. 2.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on 12/30/2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
