**Project Title:** Poplar Avenue Pump Station Replacement Project Amendment (Streambed Alteration Agreement 1600-2016-0036-R3)

**Project Location (San Mateo County):** The project is located at the Poplar Avenue Pump Station on Poplar Creek, tributary to San Francisco Bay, south of the Poplar Creek Golf Course approximately 500 feet south of the Coyote Point Marina, in the City of San Mateo, County of San Mateo, State of California; Latitude 37.5835903 and Longitude -122.3159695.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed a major amendment to Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2016-0036-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of San Mateo Public Works Department.

The major amendment is limited to modifying on-site mitigation requirements to a nearby off-site location due to utility complications. Permanent impacts to perennial wetland habitat at the Poplar Avenue Pump Station will be mitigated by incorporating 0.134 acre of excess perennial wetland mitigation at Coyote Point Pump Station site (Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2016-0037-R3).

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on March 11, 2024 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings **were not** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The Final EIR prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of project approval as a Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
