Project Title: Coyote Gulch Erosion Control Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-17340-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Coyote Gulch, an ephemeral tributary of Coyote Creek within the Prairie City State Vehicular Recreation Area (SVRA), in the County of Sacramento, State of California; Latitude 38.601939, Longitude -121.164775, Assessor's Parcel Number 072-0110-028-0000. The Prairie City SVRA is located at 13300 White Rock Road, Rancho Cordova, CA 95742.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-17340-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the California Department of Parks and Recreation as represented by Brian Dewey.

The project is limited to the stream rehabilitation of the Coyote Gulch channel as a part of an 18.5-acre erosion control restoration at the Prairie City SVRA. During project activities, the stream channel will be reestablished to its former configuration, a vegetated bioswale will be established, designated culvert crossings will be constructed, and the stream channel will be fenced to protect the restored channel from unrestricted vehicular use. Project activities include rehabilitation of 3054 feet of stream channel and installation of five culvert crossings.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
