**Project Title:** Tahoe Donner Assoc. Alder Creek Trail Realignment (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. NEV-19082-R2)

**Project Location:** 15275 Alder Creek Rd Truckee, CA 96161 in the County of Nevada.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number NEV-19082-R2), pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Tahoe Donner Association. The Project consists of rerouting a portion of the Alder Creek trail so it does not go through an intermittent tributary to Alder Creek. The trail will be moved approximately 300 feet to the west. The old trail route will be decommissioned and restored. A culvert in a nearby manmade ditch will be removed.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
