Project Description:

The purpose of the Project is to supply domestic water to the would supply domestic water to the communities of Salton Sea Beach, Desert Shores, Salton City and unincorporated areas in Riverside and Imperial Counties. This project would consolidate Coachella Valley Water District's Improvement District 11 public water system with Coachella Valley Water District's Cove Community

Public Agency Approving Project: The Coachella Valley Water District is carrying out the Project. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Drinking Water (DDW) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The Division of Drinking Water has issued a drinking water supply permit for the above described Project on 2/25/2021 and has made the following California Environmental Quality Act determinations regarding the Project:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to the effects within the State Water Board's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. The State Water Board has considered the Initial Study Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of the State Water Board's approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was adopted by the State Water Board for this Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by the State Water Board for the Project.
6. Findings were not made by the State Water Board pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
