Project Location (Santa Clara County): The Project will including maintenance activities as needed along approximately 275 miles of creeks managed by Valley Water in the following municipalities: the cities of Campbell, Cupertino, Gilroy, Los Altos, Milpitas, Morgan Hill, Monte Sereno, Mountain View, Palo Alto, San Jose, Santa Clara, Saratoga, Sunnyvale, and the towns of Los Altos Hills and Los Gatos.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has amended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (1600-2011-0336-R3), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, Jennifer Codienne/Santa Clara Valley Water District (Valley Water).

The Project involves amending the Stream Maintenance Program to account for updates to the SMP manual and includes the addition of concrete removal for mitigation purposes, and mitigation in the Pajaro watershed.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
