Title: Vista Grande Drainage Improvement Project

Proponent: City of Daly City, Department of Water and Wastewater Resources

Location: Sovereign tide and submerged land in the Pacific Ocean, adjacent to Fort Funston, City and County of San Francisco

Description: The Vista Grande Drainage Improvement Project is a stormwater storage and recovery project to address storm-related flooding in the Vista Grande Drainage Basin while providing additional benefits of augmenting the water level of Lake Merced. The State Lands Commission action is issuance of a 35-year General Lease – Right-of-Way Use for the demolition and removal of a concrete outfall structure; removal and replacement of abandoned pipeline support structures; use, maintenance, and repair of an existing 33-inch diameter submarine outfall pipeline with diffusers in the Pacific Ocean.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as  Lead Agency  Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on October 25, 2022, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project  will  will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) An  Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was prepared pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures  were  were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan  was or  was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations  was  was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings  were  were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, City of Daly City, certified the Environmental Impact Report/Statement (EIR/EIS) and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program and approved the project on December 22, 2020. The California State Lands Commission has considered the EIR/EIS as prepared for this project by City of Daly City, and adopted an independent Mitigation Monitoring Program incorporating City of Daly City's document.
