**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The California Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) proposes to adopt the Northwest Omnibus Fuels Treatment Project consistent with the Calaveras Big Trees State Park Vegetation Management Plan Adopted on June 25, 2018. The project will conduct fuel reduction treatment within the mixed conifer forest habitat, create piles for future burning, and burn piles with the required air and burn permits, and during the appropriate seasons.
