Project Title: Line 103 Anomaly Repairs and Road Maintenance Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0200-R4)

Project Location: The Project is located in Kern County approximately seven miles northeast of the City of Taft and adjacent to State Route 119, Kern County, State of California; Township 31 South, Range 24 East, Sections 12 and 13, United States Geological Survey (USGS) map Buena Vista Lake Bed, MDB&M; and Township 31 South, Range 25 East, Sections 5 and 7 of USGS map Tupman, and Section 7 of USGS map Buena Vista Lake Bed, MDB&M; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 298-090-20, 184-020-17, 184-020-15, and 184-020-31.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0200-R4, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Southern California Gas Company.

The Project will consist of activities related to the repair of two damaged sections of steel natural gas pipeline and grading to restore an existing access road at 11 stream crossings.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 3/20/19 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
