Project Title: Saratoga to Skyline Trail (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0058-R3)

Project Location: The Project is located within Sanborn County Park at 16055 Sanborn Road, Saratoga, Santa Clara County, California, 95070 on an existing network of trails near the junction of Highway 9 and Sanborn Road. The coordinates are 37.245935° N latitude and 122.066539° W longitude for the Sanborn Creek bridge (#SS-01) and 37.244218° N latitude and 122.066668° W longitude for the Aubry Creek bridge (#SS-02) (NAD 83 or WGS 84). The Assessor's Parcel Number is 517-04-061.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0058-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, County of Santa Clara, Department of Parks and Recreation.

The Project includes installation of two pedestrian bridges. One bridge will be on Sanborn Creek (SS #01) and the other on Aubry Creek (SS #02). Each bridge will be approximately 50 feet long and 10 feet wide. The bridge decking, cross bracing, and abutments will be constructed using cedar or redwood timber.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on August 19, 2019, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
