Project Title: McFadden Little Lake Farm Stream Crossings Project
(Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-06326-R1)

Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the Upper Eel River watershed, approximately 2 miles north east of the town of Willits, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 16, T18N, R13W, Mt. Diablo Meridian; in the Willits U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 103-19-021; latitude 39.4141 N and longitude -123.3123 W.

Project Description: The project is limited to one (1) encroachment. One encroachment is for upgrading a failing crossing with 4 undersized culverts from an unnamed tributary to Berry Creek. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
