Project Title: Davidson Stream Crossing Project and Spring Diversion
(Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-MEN-08652-R1_ Davidson)

Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the Eel River watershed, approximately 7 miles West of the town of Legget, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 31, T24N, R15W, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Bell Springs U.S. Geological Survey US Topo map; Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 056-440-12; latitude 39.8847 N and longitude 123.5874 W at the stream crossing project (STX-1). An additional Point of Diversion (POD) occurs on APN 056-440-13; the place of use occurs on APN 056-440-13

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-MEN-08652-R1_ Davidson, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Ms. Satya Davidson.

The project is limited to 2 encroachments. The first proposed encroachment is to upgrade a failing and undersized stream crossing. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly sized crossing, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. The second encroachments is for a water diversion for domestic use only. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure and filling in a machine dug hole near the spring box along with extending and replacing the pig fencing and barb wire surrounding the spring area. This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21081, subdivision (a).
