**Project Title:** Styles Stream Crossing (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-MEN-12336-R1)

**Project Location (include county):** The project to be completed is located within the Eel River watershed, approximately one mile Northwest of the town of Leggett, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located at 62800 Page & Gates Road; Assessor's Parcel Number 053-370-34-00; latitude 39.86898 N and longitude -123.71868 W at the center of the parcel.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-MEN-12336-R1, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Ethan Styles.

The project is limited to one encroachment. This encroachment is to upgrade an undersized culvert. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the culvert, replacement with new properly sized culvert, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on February 8, 2021 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
