Project Title: Billy Bob's Tweed Factory - 2021 (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-MEN-06948-R1)

Project Location (include county): The project is located on unnamed tributaries to Hensley Creek, within the Russian River watershed, associated with Assessor's Parcel No. 152-210-09-00, latitude 39.2019 longitude -123.2834, approximately 5 miles west of the town of Ukiah, County of Mendocino, State of California.

Project Description: The project is limited to the following activities: 1) maintenance of an existing stream crossing; and 2) commercial cannabis cultivation. Work for these project locations may include include backfilling and compaction of fill, erosion control and rock armoring as necessary at the stream crossing.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
