Project Location (include county): The project is in the Middle Fork Eel River watershed at 71600 Hill Road, Covelo, in the County of Mendocino, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 034-310-34-00, Latitude 39.754218, Longitude -123.203474 the center of the parcel.

Project Description: The project is limited to 1 encroachment. The proposed encroachment is to stabilize a stream bank where erosion has been occurring due to a previous cannabis cultivation that has since been moved. The stabilization will include a bioengineered solution along 30-linear feet of Turner Creek.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
