**Project Title:** Warner Crossing Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-MEN-04578-R1)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located within the South Fork Eel watershed, approximately 7.1 miles north east of the town of Ukiah, County of Mendocino, State of California; Section 7, T16N, R11W, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, in the Redwood Valley U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 176-100-200; latitude 39.2501 N and longitude -123.1261 W at the first crossing.

**Project Description:** The project is limited to 3 encroachments. Three encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized stream crossings. Work for these encroachment(s) will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly sized crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. The notification included descriptions of projects that may be subject to CDFG Code 1600 such as, an onstream reservoir, many culverts, and points of diversion but were not included as paid projects and are not covered under this Agreement.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
