
**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0153-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Lisandra Hernandez Pombo.

The project is limited to 3 encroachments. Two encroachments are for improving existing armored fill crossings by excavating and adding rock as necessary to minimize erosion. The other proposed encroachment is to decommission a stream crossing by excavating fill in the channel and recontouring the stream banks.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
