**Project Title:** Hodson Stream Crossing and Grading Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-MEN-26819-R1C).

**Project Location:** The project is located approximately four miles east of the Town of Navarro; affecting one unnamed tributary to the Navarro River in the County of Mendocino, State of California; Section 24, Township 15N, Range 15W; Humboldt Base and Meridian, in the Bailey Ridge, Calif. 7.5-minute quadrangle, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map; Assessor's Parcel Number: 026-236-09-00.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-MEN-26819-R1C, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Tony Hodson. The project consists of one encroachment: One encroachment is to upgrade existing culvert and to regrade the driveway and landing pad to reduce sediment delivery to the stream. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the existing culvert, replacement with a new properly sized culvert, backfilling and compaction of fill, rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion, and road reshaping through grading.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above-described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
