**Project Title:** Krueger Stream Crossing Project, Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-MEN-29636-R1C

**Project Location:** The project to be completed is located within the Lake Mendocino-East Fork Russian River watershed, approximately three miles southeast of the town of Redwood Valley, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 12, T16N, R12W, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Redwood Valley U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 176-020-12.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-MEN-29636-R1C, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Stephen Krueger.

The project is limited to one (1) encroachment to replace two 30-inch double barrel culverts with a seasonal rock ford crossing. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the existing culverts, and installation of a rock ford crossing. Vehicles shall not be operated on the crossing when water is present.

The crossing shall accommodate the estimated 100-year flood flow, including debris and sediment. Final construction plans for the crossing shall be submitted to CDFW for review and acceptance within three (3) months from the effective date of this Agreement, after which the Permittee shall allow 60 days for CDFW review and written acceptance prior to project implementation.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.  
CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
