Project Title: Harms Well Use and Monitoring Project, Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-MEN-28815-R1C

Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the South Fork Eel River watershed, approximately two miles northwest of the town of Laytonville, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 35, T22N, R15W, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Cahto Peak U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 013-790-20-01; latitude 39.710621 N and longitude 123.504731 W.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-MEN-28815-R1C, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Corey Harms.

The project is limited to one (1) encroachment for use and monitoring of a 165-foot deep well, hydraulically connected to Tenmile Creek, as a water source for irrigation.
