Project Location: Unnamed tributary to East Fork Russian River Tributary to the Russian River, Redwood Valley, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 33, Township 16N, Range 12W, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, in the Redwood Valley U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 161-250-08-00; latitude 39.2780N, longitude 123.1989W

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-MEN-38484-R1C), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, the project Applicant, Anarbol Lopez.

The project is limited to one encroachment for the upgrading of an existing spillway. The encroachment is for reconstructing of the upper spillway with reenforced concrete, installing grouted 18" diameter rock within the concrete at the transition to the lower spillway, and replacing the concrete with CalTrans Class V rock (D50 = 18") in the lower spillway, and removing the concrete ford below the spillway and installing a rock armored channel comprised of D50 = 18" rock.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on April 12, 2023 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
