It is specifically located at 1631 Airport Boulevard, and is centered at approximately 38.511226, -122.795825 on Assessor Parcel Numbers 059-430-001 and 059-430-002.**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0181-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Airport Business Center represented by Larry L. Wasem.

In 2018, Airport Business Center removed vegetation to prepare for Airport Boulevard widening and culvert removal activities. The project is limited to widening of Airport Boulevard, installing a bioretention swale, removing a culvert, and restoring riparian habitat to offset impacts from Airport Business Center's vegetation removal activities.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on June 22, 2020, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration and addendum prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
