Project Title: Federico Westpark Market Street Outfall (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0078-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at Federico Creek, in the County of Placer, State of California; Latitude 38.765842, Longitude -121.384185; Section 35, Township 11N, Range 5E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map 'Pleasant Grove', Mt. Diablo base and meridian; Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 017-150-035.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0078-R2-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Solaire Community Builders, LLC, as represented by Jeff Jones.

The project is part of the Sierra Vista Specific Plan and is associated with the Federico Westpark Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0039-R2). The project consists of the grading and excavation for the installation of a stormwater outfall and vegetated water quality swale that would tie into Federico Creek. The stormwater outfall will consist of a 78-foot-long 15-inch-wide reinforced concrete pipe with a 15-inch flared end.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
