**Project Title:** FD-2 Outfall (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. PLA-37297-R2)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located at Federico Creek, in the County of Placer, State of California; approximately centered at Latitude 38.761719, Longitude -121.395627 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees); Assessor's Parcel Number 499-010-008-000. The property is located north of Vista Grande Blvd and west of Westbrook Blvd, Roseville, CA, 95747.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number PLA-37297-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Beazer Home (Taylor Bollinger).

The project is limited to the construction of a bioretention water quality basin with two outfalls as well as a sewer line, with a subsequent access road to be constructed atop the sewer line.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
