Project Title: Cordova Hills Off-site Water Improvement (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-40485-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at an unnamed ephemeral drainage to Laguna Creek, in the City of Rancho Cordova, County of Sacramento, State of California at latitude 38.553128° and longitude -121.187516°.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SAC-40485-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Bruce Bell.

The project is limited to the construction of transmission mains with an access road built on top of them. The transmission mains and access road work are part of a larger project that consists of the construction of two ductile iron transmission mains running parallel to Grant Line Road between Douglas Road and Chrysanthy Boulevard in the City of Rancho Cordova to serve the planned Cordova Hills development. Vegetation removal, excavation for the transmission mains installations, and backfilling and paving a concrete access road over the transmission mains will be done within the stream channel.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made as a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.

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6. Findings were made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
