Title: State Route 1 Lagunitas Creek Bridge Project

Applicant: California Department of Transportation

Location: Sovereign land located in Lagunitas Creek on State Route 1, near Point Reyes Station, Marin County

Description: Caltrans proposes to replace the bridge crossing Lagunitas Creek on SR 1. The State Lands Commission action is an Issuance of a Public Agency Permit and approval of a Right-of-Way Map, including Temporary Construction Easements, through December 31, 2028.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on October 17, 2024, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was prepared pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) certified the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and adopted an Avoidance, Minimization and/or Mitigation Summary and approved the project on June 29, 2018. The California State Lands Commission has considered the EIR as prepared for this project by Caltrans and adopted an independent Mitigation Monitoring Program incorporating Caltrans' document.
