The Project is a 7.5-mile multi-use bicycle and pedestrian trail extending along the railroad corridor from Wilder Ranch State Park on the south to Davenport on the north in unincorporated Santa Cruz County. The Project includes a paved path with striping, parallel unpaved path and shoulder, and parking improvements with trail connections at three locations along the alignment. The trail will be located almost exclusively along the coastal side of the existing railroad tracks, largely consistent with the Monterey Bay Sanctuary Scenic Trail Network Master Plan.
